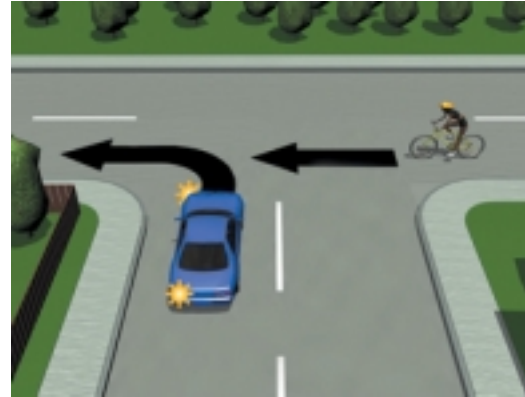

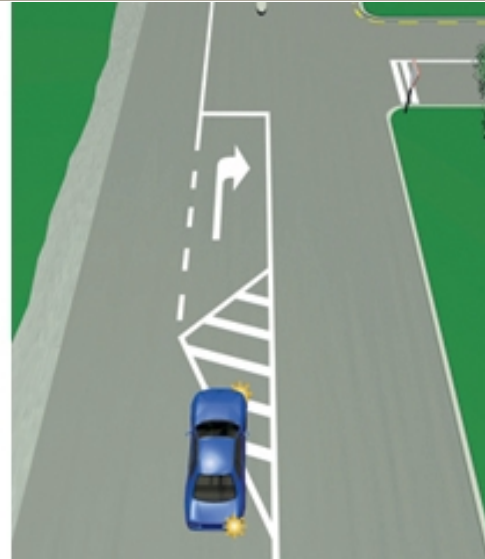

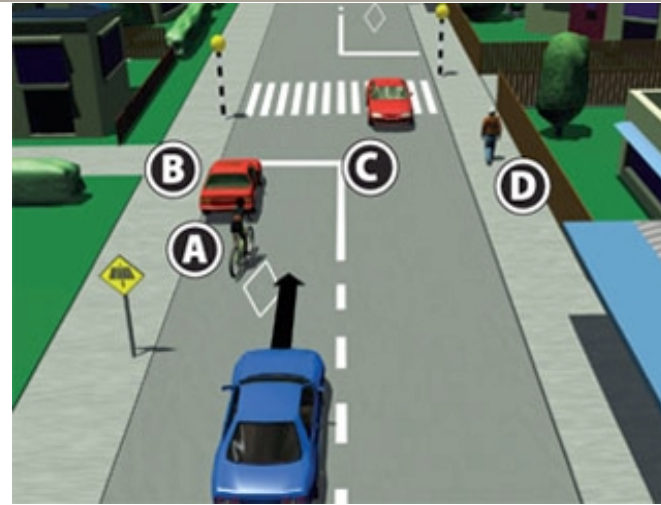

**Question Number 34 of 35**
